Cornouaille is a true cradle of Breton culture. Discover our top 6 events, where dance, music, art, and traditional costumes blend beautifully.

- Festival de Cornouaille**  
Quimper → July  
Held in the historic heart of Quimper since 1923, this must-attend event celebrates Breton culture over four days with more than 150 activities, traditional costume parades, fest-noz dances, and over 2,000 musicians and dancers.
- Les Filets Bleus**  
Quartier portuaire de Concarneau → August  
At the foot of the centuries-old ramparts, the 103rd edition offers a rich program of entertainment and concerts. Don't miss the grand parade in the city center on Sunday, featuring traditional costumes.
- Fête des Brodeuses**  
Pont-Abbé → July  
A weekend dedicated to the craftsmanship and traditions of Pays Bigouden. Experience embroidery demonstrations, music competitions, parades, and performances in the heart of the Bigouden capital.
- Les Nuits Celtiques de Peniti**  
La Forêt-Fouesnant → July/August  
Every Wednesday evening, enjoy performances of traditional Breton music and dance from Cornouaille's finest groups, set in a picturesque bay near the marina.
- La Fête des Bruyères**  
Beuzec-Cap-Sizun → August  
With breathtaking views over Douarnenez Bay, Celtic groups parade between the village and the stunning Pointe de Kastel Koz, accompanied by a dozen decorated floats and elegant Breton horses.
- Grande Troménie de Locronan**  
Locronan → July  
This sacred pilgrimage covers over 12 kilometers through the Parzay plain and the Prieuré mountain. Held only once every six years, the route is marked by 12 stations with granite crosses and 42 huts sheltering ancient statues of saints.

- Festival des Rias**  
Pays de Quimperlé → August  
Spread across several towns, this street theater festival wraps up the summer season with a spectacular finale and numerous contemporary performances.

## Water sports activities

Enjoy the pristine natural landscapes of Cornouaille with these tips: Check the weather before setting out, stay within supervised areas, seek advice from professionals, and avoid going out alone.

### Here are some must-visit highlights

**From Concarneau to Pont-Aven**  
Between the Bay of Concarneau, the Aven River, and the wild coast of Névez and Tréguinc, water sports enthusiasts will find their happiness: kayaking, surfing, sailing, paddleboarding.

**Audierne Bay, from Penhors to Saint-Jean-Trolimon**  
20-kilometer-long bay with numerous beaches and varying conditions for all skill levels. La Torche in Plomerec is Brittany's most famous surf spot.

**Sillon Beach on L'Île-Tudy**  
A one-kilometer-long sandy beach, ideal for families. A protected dune area invites you to take walks with panoramic views of Anse de Bénodet, the tip of Île-Tudy, Locudy, and the Pont-l'Abbé estuary.

**The Beaches and Headlands of Fouesnant-les Glénan**  
In Moustelin, the beaches stretch from Kerneuc to Kerambigorn, while in Beg-Meil, they extend from Plage des Oiseaux to the vast beach of Cap-Coz—perfect for relaxation, water sports, family activities, or a seaside picnic.

**In the bay of Douarnenez**  
Sheltered beaches like Trémaloouen in Kerlaz, Ris Beach, Sables Blancs, and Pars Cap in Douarnenez offer relaxation, swimming, and stunning views of the Crozon Peninsula.

**Baie des Trépassés in Plogoff**  
The beaches of Cap-Sizun, including Baie des Trépassés and Pars Théolen, captivate with their wild beauty—ideal for relaxation, water sports, and surfing.

**The Rias from Aven to Doëlan**  
From l'Aven to the beaches of Le Pouldu, you'll find an ideal setting and coastal walks.

## Explore differently

Cornouaille offers beautiful cycling routes for all levels. Whether alone, with family, or friends, explore the Véloroute V45, which follows the entire coastline. You can also try the Véloroute V7, perfect for discovering the inland areas.

This is not an exhaustive list, find all detailed routes and trails at the Tourist Office or on their websites.

- In Quimper, take the greenways.
- Head south to Pont-l'Abbé along the old railway for a peaceful ride to the Bigouden capital. To the north, cycle to Douarnenez, passing through calm, wooded landscapes.
- Around Quimperlé, ride inland through state forests or along the rias. Try the Balade des Moulins in Locouanol (20 km) or explore the new 7 km section of the Véloroute V45 between Moëlan-sur-Mer and Riec-sur-Bélon.
- In Cap-Sizun, enjoy five marked mountain bike loops for all levels. These trails cover 170 km of varied terrain, from cliffs and valleys to stunning coastal scenery.



## MTB routes

### Two Major Cycling Routes Cross the Destination

- The Véloroute V45 - The Coastal Route  
Like the famous GR® 34 Customs Path, the Véloroute V45 - The Coastal Route will eventually follow the Breton coastline from Roscoff to Nantes. You can already explore eight beautiful stages in the Quimper Cornouaille region. You can already explore eight beautiful stages in the Quimper Cornouaille region.
- The Véloroute V7 connects the English Channel to the Atlantic, running from Concarneau to Roscoff along a former railway line. In the Quimper Cornouaille region, it stretches for about 30 km, passing through Soëff and Rosporden before reaching Concarneau.
- Connecting Routes to the V5/V45 - The Coastal Route  
Several routes link Quimper to the V5/V45 Coastal Route, including the Quimper-Douarnenez and Quimper-Pont-l'Abbé connections. The Quimper-Fouesnant connection is partially completed, starting from Moulins du Pont.

### A Multi-Day MTB Circuit in the Pays de Quimperlé

Unique in Brittany, the MTB circuit in the Pays de Quimperlé covers 163 km of marked trails (MTB Route No. 1). Between forests, countryside, and coastline, this route challenges mountain bikers of all levels. The journey can be completed in two to three days.

## Hiking in Cornouaille

**The GR® 34**  
A true gem among hiking trails, the GR® 34 is open to everyone, all year round. This historic coastal path, shaped by the sea and salt, stretches for nearly 350 km across Cornouaille.

**The GR® 38**  
This 80 km trail runs through Cornouaille. From Douarnenez, passing artistic towns, rolling landscapes, and museums, it reveals the Angoulême, Brittany's inland region, with key stops in Quimper and Locronan.

**Connecting Trails**  
between the GR® 34 et le GR® 38:  
 • Pont-Saint-Maurice to Pont-Neuf Plauay: 45.5 km of distance;  
 • Quimper to Pont de Cornouaille Combrit: 23 km of distance.



### Three Long-Distance Trails GR® in Cornouaille:

- GR® de Pays Cap-Sizun: 120 km  
Explore the Grand Site de France of Pointe du Raz. Starting from Audierne's lively port, the trail takes you along dramatic cliffs and a unique ecosystem, with key stops at the Cap-Sizun Nature Reserve and the Maison de Site in Plogoff.
- GR® de Pays Bigouden: 96 km  
Discover Bigouden history and culture on this scenic hike. Starting in Pont-l'Abbé, the cultural capital of the region, follow the coast and immerse yourself in the life of the local fishermen.
- GR® de Pays Tour des Portes de Cornouaille: 192 km  
Walk in the footsteps of artists like Paul Gauguin, Paul Sérusier, and Gustave Flaubert. From Clohars-Carnoët to Quimperlé, then Pont-Aven to Rosporden and Concarneau, this trail loops back to your starting point, passing rias and coastal paths.
